## Source Analysis — Sentence Starters

### “Source A is useful because it reveals...”

*Think about: What does Source A tell us about how the Japanese government wants people to understand Hashima Island? What specific claims does it make?*

### “However, Source A is limited because...”

*Think about: What information is missing? What does Source A not tell us about the island’s history? Why might this matter?*

### “Source G is useful for a different reason...”

*Think about: What perspective does Source G offer that Source A does not? Who created Source G, and how does that affect what it includes?*

### “When we consider both sources together...”

*Think about: What can we learn by comparing these two accounts? What does the difference between them tell us about how heritage sites are used?*

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
